## Notice of Change of Use of Agricultural and Timberland (Waiver of Notice and Protest)

**INSTRUCTIONS:** Texas law requires you to notify the District if your land qualifies for agricultural or timber-use valuation and you change its use. Your 'change of use' report should be filed as soon as the change as possible, but no later than April 30<sup>th</sup> following the date of change occurs. If you fail to notify the District of a change of use by the deadline, a tax penalty can be assessed against you. The penalty is 10% of the difference between the taxes you paid on the special valuation and the taxes you would have paid on the market value of the land. **I am aware that by waiving my right to protest the Notice of Change of Use Determination, rollback taxes will be imposed by each taxing unit taxing the property.**
